Aim of SAUSF for University sports & students

SAUSF is a regional arm for International University Sports Federation, Switzerland / FISU & Asian University Sports Federation /AUSF China in this region and established in 2013 at Kathmandu, Nepal.

Member criteria (shall cover minimum 2 points):

1. Country's National University Sports Federation/ NUF, shall approved & recommended by HRD/ Higher Education ministry of the country to govern University Sports curriculum.
2. Or Country's National University Sports Federation/ NUF, shall approved and recommended by Ministry of Sports & Youth Affair.
3. Or Country's National University Sports Federation/ NUF, shall approved by National Olympic Committee.

Important: Only elected member from NUF/ NUSF ie Hony. President or Hony. Secy. or both from a NUSF could be part of general body.

Regional Area: Bangladesh, India, Nepal, Bhutan, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Maldives (under establishment).

Sports Criteria: All Olympic & Non- Olympic games & sports but shall into SAUSF, AUSF or into FISU charter.

Our scope of work:

1. Organize friendly, competitive matches with any global Continental/Regional University Sports Federation (s).
2. Plan and help to NUSF to implement AUSF & FISU methodology in SA region.
3. Maintain and share annual report of member(s) country on yearly basis.
4. Plan and conduct all types of Sports related projects ie seminar & conclave on Medical Science, Physical Education, anti doping, award ceremonies & functions along-with exchange, training program, friendly matches etc..for University students.
5. Get association of Govt., National Sports Federation(s), NGO etc. to plan & execute various national- international projects.
6. First time SAUSF planning to conduct SAUSF Games, tentatively in 2023.
